

Waste Management Plan

Ocean going vessels of 40 feet or longer with a galley and berth must have a written Waste Management Plan.

All persons boarding this vessel, _____ be aware that under NO circumstances will any garbage, plastic material, food, aluminum cans, bottles, sewage and hazardous substances, etc. be thrown overboard. You must also advise the captain in case of any oily discharges or diesel spills that you might observe.
